Dr. Ewers graduated in 1971 from the Medical University of Freiburg, Germany. He completed his surgery training at Downstate Medical University Center, Brooklyn, USA (1973) and Oral, Maxillofacial and Plastic Surgery training at the University Hospital of Freiburg, Germany (1974-1979), then served as Deputy Chief of Hospital for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and Regional Plastic Surgery at the University Hospital in Kiel, Germany (1980-1989).

Dr. Ewers is President of ISCAS (International Society for Computer Aided Surgery), President of the Camlog Foundation and Camlog Academy, and Inventor of the porous hydroxyapatite material Algipore®.

He is member of numerous professional organizations, recipient of multiple awards in Europe and North America and has an impressive portfolio as a scholar and researcher as well, with 20 chapters in text books and over 400 publications.

Dr. Ewers lectures extensively in Austria and abroad on cutting edge technologies in surgery. He is associated with the development of 3-D-reconstruction models by stereolithography and first clinical use of an intraoperative navigation system by means of the augmented reality and clinical implementation of the VPS-Virtual Patient System with Telesurgery.
