

Iuliia Romanova DMS, PhD, Professor Department of Therapeutic Dentistry Odessa National Medical University Odessa, Ukraine



Iuliia Romanova is a dentistry educationalist, researcher and specialist. She received her MD at the Faculty of Dentistry ONMU (1994) and her first PhD in 2000. In 2013 she defended her second PhD.

She graduated from the Interregional Academy of Personnel Management (Odessa), specializing in Human Resources Management and Labor Economics (2014).

She has been a full professor since 2015. She is the scientific director of a state-funded research project destined to patients with systemic disorders of homeostasis.

She has been as a member of the Ukrainian Academy of Sciences since 2017.

She introduced a variety of products in practical healthcare, such as the oral cavity gels, the "LactoGel" for fungal lesions, or the "Profial" to prevent allergic reactions to acrylic plastics.

Since1999, she has published 218 scientific and methodological works, such as 3 textbooks for English-speaking dental students, 6 textbooks, 7 methodological recommendations used in medical and pedagogical practice. She is the holder of 20 Ukrainian patents. During the last 3 years she has admitted 6250 patients, 3637 diagnostic procedures have been performed.

She is currently the head of the association of doctors-periodontologists of the Odessa region, a member of Coordinating Council of the Association of Dentists of Ukraine, a member of the Republic Task Group "Stomatology".

She has been awarded the Honorary Certificate of the Health Administration of the Odessa Regional State Administration, and Certificates of acknowledgment from Dentsply Sirona, Association of Endodontists of Romania, Association of Dentists of Ukraine.
