Professor Sforza (DOB: June 15, 1961) is a full Professor of Human Anatomy and graduate of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery, Università degli Studi di Milano, Italy (1986). She obtained her PhD/ Residency in Sports Medicine from the same University (1989). She was Associate Professor of Human Anatomy, Faculty of Medicine and Surgery, Università degli Studi di Milano (1992-2000), and a full time Professor (same University since 2000). She was Director of the Department of Human Morphology and Biomedical Sciences "Città Studi" (2007-2012), Department of Biomedical Sciences for Health (2012-2014), and a member of the Board of Directors, Università degli Studi di Milano (2012- 2014). She served as Director, PhD School in Morphological, Physiological, and Sport Sciences (2010-2015); Director, PhD Program in Integrative Biomedical Research (2013-2018); she is currently Director, PhD Program in Translational Medicine (2018-). Her research interests focus on the functional anatomy of the stomatognathic and locomotor systems: anatomical bases of stomatognathic function and dysfunction, three-dimensional non-invasive analysis of human movement in health and disease; three-dimensional modelling of craniofacial structures in normal subjects and patients. She is Associate to the Institute of Molecular Bioimaging and Physiology, (2013-2017; 2017-2019). She published research papers in peer-reviewed international journals: Medline Articles 360; Web of Science Articles 344; Sum of the Times Cited 5301; Scopus Articles 409; Sum of the Times Cited 6540; h-index 40 (2 Nov 2018). She also serves as a member of the editorial board and reviewer of several international journals.
