Dr. Rosenstiel is an educationist, researcher and specialist in Restorative Dentistry. Presently, Professor Emeritus of Restorative and Prosthetic Dentistry at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry, where he maintains an intramural prosthodontic practice. He is a 1973 dental graduate of Birmingham University in England and completed his Masters in Prosthodontics at Indiana University in 1977. He taught fixed prosthodontics at the University of Florida and University of London before joining Ohio State in 1985. Dr. Rosenstiel is Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry*, Secretary and Past-President of the American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics, President of The Carl O Boucher Conference, Past President of the Prosthodontics Group of the International Association for Dental Research, the John F. Johnston Society for Advance Prosthodontics and the Fixed Prosthodontic Section, American Dental Education Association. He is one of the authors of the textbook "Contemporary Fixed Prosthodontics", the fifth edition of which will be published in 2015. The textbook has sold over 60,000 copies, is used in many dental schools and has been translated into eleven languages. He has authored over 180 scientific articles and abstracts, principally on the fracture properties of dental ceramics and dental esthetics. He was honored with the 2015 Distinguished Service Award from the American College of Prosthodontists (ACP) for 22 years contribution.
