Gabriela Băncescu is the head of the Microbiology Department, Faculty of Dentistry, "Carol Davila" University of Medicine and Pharmacy - Bucharest, Romania.

Dr. Băncescu graduated in 1983 from the Faculty of Medicine, "Gr. T. Popa" University of Medicine and Pharmacy - Iași, and became a senior physician in Microbiology, in 1997. She attended a, MA in Oral Microbiology at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Bergen (UiB), Norway, and was awarded her MSc in 1996. She was awarded her PhD in Bucharest in 2002, with a thesis on: "Studies on oral streptococci: their involvement in bucco-maxillofacial infections".

Prof. Băncescu was involved as a director or team member in 12 research projects, earned 8 prizes for her scientific activity and served as referent for 11 PhD theses. She authored 10 books and 100 studies published in ISI/BDI indexed journals, was a member of different organizing/scientific committee of prestigious scientific events and presented lectures, oral and poster communications in Romania and abroad (Europe, Canada and New Zealand).

Dr. Băncescu served as Secretary General of the Romanian Society of Laboratory Medicine (2009-2014) and is a member of: the Romanian Society for Microbiology, the European Society of Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases, and the board of the European Society of Chemotherapy - Infectious Diseases. She is an Associated Editor of the Romanian Journal of Rhinology (since 2011) and Editor of the Stomatology Edu Journal.

Prof. Băncescu's main scientific interest is oral microbiology.
