She served as Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry, Riga Stradins University (2003 – 2013).

She is head of the Latvian Oral Medicine and Pathology Society, Member of the European Oral Medicine Association, International Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, Honorary Member of the American Academy of Oral Medicine (2010). She was a member of Scientific advisory council Riga Stradins University (2009 – 2019), She is a member of the editorial board of journal "Stomatology. Baltic, Dental and Maxillo-facial surgery". She regularly participates in scientific conferences and seminars, lectured at the Mississippi University Dental school (2008). She authored 79 publications in peer reviewed journals, more than 70 oral and poster presentations in internationl congresses and conferences, more than 100 presentations in local conferences, seminars and meetings.
