Joannis Katsoulis serves as an Associate Professor in the Department of Prosthodontics, School of Dental Medicine, University of Bern. He is trained in Prosthodontics and Implant Dentistry with a focus on computer-assisted technologies for implant planning, placement and prosthesis fabrication in edentulous and special care patients. In 2013 he received his Habilitation in Prosthodontics and Implant Dentistry at the Medical Faculty of the University of Bern.

He conducts clinical and laboratory research projects with CAD/CAM titanium and zirconium restorations. He teaches pre- and postgraduate students in the School of Dental Medicine, University of Bern and is also an Adjunct Assistant Professor in Department of Preventive and Restorative Sciences, University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, Philadelphia, PA, USA. Dr. Katsoulis has authored approximately 30 articles in high-ranked and peer-reviewed journals (Total IF>60). He serves as a scientific reviewer for several journals and scientific associations. Dr. Katsoulis is currently the President of the scientific committee of the Swiss Society for Reconstructive Dentistry SSRD, and is a board member of the European Association of Prosthodontics EPA as well as the Swiss Dental Society for Disabled and Elderly Persons SGZBB.
