Dr. Michael Frank attended dental medicine at the Marburg and Giessen universities, graduating with a DMD, University of Giessen, Germany (1978/79).

He worked at the Giessen University as a dental assistant in anatomy, pathology and prosthetics, while attending postgraduate studies in oro-maxilo-facial surgery.

Since 1983, he has been working as a dentist in a practice partnership, focusing on oral surgery, implantology and periodontics.

Since 1987, he has been professionally active at regional and federal level. In recognition of these activities he was elected Vice-President (1992-1997), and since 1997, President of the Regional Dental Chamber of Hesse and member of the Board of the German Dental Association (BZÄK). He was elected Vice President of BZÄK in charge of Continuing, Professional Development, post-graduate education, quality assurance and guidelines in dentistry (2008-2011).

Since 2008 he has been a member of the German FDI Delegation, of the ERO-Working Group "Dental Team", ERO Treasurer and Board member since 2010, member of the German delegation for the Council of European Dentists (CED), National Liaison Officer of BZÄK in the FDI.

He is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of Quintessenz-Verlag, Berlin, lecturer and speaker; organizer and scientific director of the "European Dental Forum", which has been held annually in Frankfurt M. since 1995.

He authored and co-edited "Weissbuch Zahnmedizin" 2007 (2 volumes), Quintessenz-Verlag, Berlin. He is also a member of many scientific organizations and societies.

For his ERO-FDI work he was elected President, a position he took over in the 2019 Frankfurt Spring Session.
