Dr. Lombardo Giorgio graduated with honors from the Medicine and Surgery Department, University of Verona (1986). In 1989 he specialized in Odontostomatology at the same university. In 2002 he was appointed Associate Professor at the University of Verona to teach Periodontology and Implantology at various degree courses, including: Degree course in Dentistry and Dental Prosthesis; Degree course in Dental Hygiene; and also in the School of Specialty in Maxillofacial Surgery. Since 2003, Dr. Lombardo has coordinated the Second Level Master's Degree and the Annual Specialization Course in Periodontology. Furthermore, since 2007 he has held an annual course in Periodontal and Peri-implant Surgery at the Villafranca site. Under the direction of Prof. Pier Francesco Nocini (Department of Morphological-Biomedical Sciences of the University of Verona) he carries out clinical and research activities at the Section of Maxillofacial Surgery and Odontostomatology.

He is mainly concerned with techniques for the regeneration of periodontal and peri-implant bone deficiencies, as well as the study of oral biofilm and mechanical and chemical methods for its disintegration.

He collaborates with BICON, SUNSTAR, EPIEN, and co-operates with IDC-Italy, a provider of congressional and didactic activities.
