Professor Mutlu Özcan (DOB: June 17, 1969) received her DDS at Marmara University, Istanbul, Turkey (1993), and her DMD at the University of Cologne, Germany (1999). She continued her biomaterial study as Invited visiting researcher at the University of Turku, Finland (2001-2002). In 2003 she obtained her PhD at the Royal University of Groningen, Netherlands, and since 2007 she has been a Professor at the Clinical Dental Biomaterials at the same University. She has been Professor and Head of Department of Dental Material Science at University of Zurich, Switzerland (2009-present).

She has authored more than 450 scientific and clinical articles in peer-reviewed journals, is a sought-after lecturer, receiver of several international awards and has held numerous continuing education courses in Europe. She also serves in the editorial boards of several scientific journals. Her clinical expertise is in reconstructive dentistry.

She holds Honorary Professorship positions at various universities, such as São Paolo State University (Brazil), University of Florida (USA), University of Hong Kong (China) and "Grigore T. Popa" University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Iași (Romania, 2018).

She is an EPA-Recognized Specialist in Prosthodontics, Honorary Secretary of the European Prosthodontic Association, Past-President of the International Association of Dental Research / Dental Materials Group, Fellow of Academy of Dental Materials, Fellow of International College of Dentistry and Fellow in Dental Surgery of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. She received the "2018 IADR Distinguished Scientist Wilmer Souder Award".
