Dr. Savastano is an MD and orthodontist with extensive teaching experience in Neuromuscular Orthodontics and TMJ disorders. Since 1991 he has had his private practice (orthodontics and TMJ disorders), Albenga, Italy.

He received his MD from the University of Naples, Italy (1987) and his specialty degree in Orthodontics and Gnathology from the University of Padua, Italy (1990). Since 1988 he has focused on applying Neuromuscular principals to orthodontics. He developed a unique orthodontic diagnostic and treatment protocol and conceived Neuromuscular Orthodontics as a distinct branch of the orthodontic specialty (San Paolo, Brazil, 1994, Savasystem). He conceived the Orthodontic Office Software ("Project Orfeus") at the Department of Engineering, University of Genoa, Italy, 2001, and the orthodontic bracket prescription, Savasystem made by GC Orthodontics (Japan), 2016.

He has lectured worldwide since 1989 to over 1000 doctors. He has acquired extensive experience for complex TMJ pathologies and maxillo-facial surgery as a hospital consultant for 15 years. He served as adjunct professor for the Neuromuscular Orthodontics Masters at the University Jaume I of De Valls, Andorra (2015-2017), adjunct professor for the Neuromuscular Orthodontics and Cranio-Mandibular Orthopedics Masters at the University Jaume I, Castellon, Spain, continues to motivate skilled orthodontists to confidently achieve a higher level in their profession.

He is a member of the American Association of Orthodontics, World Federation of Orthodontics, International College of Craniomandibular Orthopedics. He founded and has been a president of ICNOG since 2006, while striving to improve diagnostic and treatment procedures in Neuromuscular Orthodontics.
