She currently serves as Dental Consultant (National Committee for University Education and Accreditation, Argentina), International Director of the Postgraduate Career of Dentistry for Children and Adolescents (UDD; Chile), and Member of the IADR Awards Committee (2016/2019).

She has received a number of awards and honors, including the “Academic Excellence” (University of Buenos Aires; 2018), “Notable person in Health Sciences” (Legislative Chamber, Buenos Aires City, 2017), Award to Professional Career (CEDIQUIFA and CAESPO; 2014), Senior Researcher (IADR/Latin American Region; 2012), Great Master in Dentistry (University of Buenos Aires; 2009 and 2010), and more than 15 awards and honorable mentions for research projects or scientific activities.
