Dr. Massironi (DOB: September 1st, 1954) is an educationist, administrator, researcher and specialist in prosthetics and implantology. He has established a private practice in Melegnano, Italy focusing exclusively on prosthetics, aesthetics and implantology, using the operating microscope since 1988.

He graduated with honours in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Pavia and specialized in Dentistry at the same University with honours too.

He has lectured extensively both nationally and internationally. He is Diplomate of ICOI (International Congress of Oral Implantologists), Active Member of EAED (European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry), Active Member of AMED (the Academy of Microscope Enhanced Dentistry), Member Emeritus Amici di Brugg, and Founder CAD/CAM Academy.

He has published several articles and co-authored two books published by Quintessence, namely "Precision in prosthetic restoration" and "Precision in dental esthetics", also translated in nine languages.

He is a member of the editorial board of The European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry and the International Journal of Micro Dentistry.

He conceived the marginal design of preparation called modified chamfer and of this shape and design of finishing line, was the first in the world to develop oscillating instruments with ultrasonic and sonic drive. He makes extensive presentations worldwide of his method in fixed prosthodontics and innovative treatment modalities in preparation teeth phase and aesthetic dentistry, in the field of dental implant therapy, before prominent national and international dental academics, and professional institutions, thus gaining widespread international recognition .
