Professor Nissan (DOB: January 1, 1962) is a dentist, researcher and specialist in Oral-Rehabilitation.

He received his DMD (1991) and his Prosthodontics (1997) degrees, from Tel-Aviv University School of Dental Medicine, Israel.

Since 2014 he has served as Head of Oral-Rehabilitation and Implant-Prosthodontics, at the Rabin Medical Center, Beilinson Campus, Petah Tikva.

He has been a member of the Prosthodontics Department since 1992, he is the former Director of the Implantology-Unit (2002-2009), and the Prosthodontics postgraduate program. He also serves as a member of the Board of Directors and various committees at the School of Dental Medicine, Tel Aviv University.

He has served as President of the "Israel Society of Implant-Dentistry" (since 2011), and was the former President of the "Israel Prosthodontic Society" (2004-2006).

He has also acted as Chairman of the "National board of Prosthodontics Professional Committee" at the Israel Dental Association and Israel Ministry of Health since 2012. Since 2016 he has been a member of various counsels and committees with the Israel Dental Association.

He has served as member of various editorial boards in the fields of prosthodontics, dental implants. He has published over 100 original, peer reviewed research and review articles, 10 book chapters and more than 100 abstracts, and has been cited in the literature over 3000 times (H-index of 33).

Research interests: (1) biomechanical aspects in implant-prosthodontics; (2) mandibular implant-supported overdenture; (3) the importance of impression techniques in Prosthodontics; (4) esthetic and restorative outcome of implant support prosthesis in atrophic alveolar ridges situations
