Professor Aldo Fabián Squassi (DOB: April 26th, 1963) is an educationist, administrator, researcher and specialist in preventive and community dentistry. He received his DDS from the School of Dentistry, University of Buenos Aires, Buenos Aires, Argentina (1985) and finished the Advanced Training Program in General Dentistry of the Eastman Dental Center, Rochester, NY (1987). He obtained his PhD at the University of Buenos Aires (1990). In 1993, he was appointed Director of the High Risk Patient Dental Care Unit of the School of Dentistry, University of Buenos Aires, specialized in treating immunocompromised patients. He has been Chair Professor of the Department of Preventive and Community Dentistry of the University of Buenos Aires since 2009. He was President of the Argentine Division of the International Association for Dental Research (2008 – 2009). He has directed research projects accredited by different institutions, authored chapters in dentistry books and research papers published in national and international scientific journals. He has been a lecturer in national and international scientific meetings and directed doctoral and MA theses. He was Professor at the Universidad Nacional de Cuyo (Argentina), Universidad Nacional de Córdoba (Argentina), Universidad Nacional de Rosario (Argentina), Universidad del Desarrollo (Chile) and Universidad Andrés Bello (Chile). In 2018, he was appointed Vice-Dean of the School of Dentistry of the University of Buenos Aires and he is Acting Director of the Institute for Public Health Research of the University of Buenos Aires (2019).

Research interests: epidemiology of oral diseases, behavioral sciences, health services and community dentistry.
