Ralf Janda (DOB, 1953, Berlin) studied chemistry at the Free University Berlin, obtained his degree as Diploma Chemist in 1978 and graduated there as natural science doctor (Dr. rer. nat.) in 1979. In 1992 he obtained his habilitation and the degree Privatdozent (associate professor) in dental material science at the Medical Faculty, Johann Wolfgang Goethe-University, Frankfurt/M. In 2006 he was appointed as apl. Professor (adjunct professor) in dental material science at the Centre of Dentistry of the Medical Faculty, Heinrich Heine University, Düsseldorf and has held this position until now.

Professional Life: since 1980 he worked for many different international leading dental companies in leading positions (head of R&D, production, quality assurance, dental technology, worldwide project leader) until 2003. He is a member of many dental standard commissions and of the drug commission at the drug institute (Federal Republic of Germany). Between 2003 – 2017 he was the technical director of a leading cosmetic company specialized on light-curing artificial nail products.

Scientific life as researcher and lecturer: 1988 - 1990 resin composite materials, Faculty of Material Sciences, Technical University Berlin; 1991 - 1999 non-metallic dental materials, Medical Faculty, Johann Wolfgang Goethe-University Frankfurt/M.; 1999-2004 Center of Dental Medicine, Medical Faculty Charité, Humboldt-University Berlin; 2004 up to now dental clinic, Medical Faculty, Heinrich Heine University Düsseldorf.
