Professor Sanda Mihaela Popescu, (DOB: May 09, 1971), is an educationist, administrator, researcher and specialist in Oral Rehabilitation and Medical and Surgical Emergencies. She is Head of Oral Rehabilitation and Medical and Surgical Emergencies Department, Faculty of Dental Medicine, University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Craiova, Romania. Her main activities and responsibilities cover teaching, researching and organizing the department activity. She gained her leadership experience as a head of a department within the Faculty of Dental Medicine (2008-2019).

She graduated from the Craiova Sanitary Highschool as top of her class (1989) and then graduated from the Dental School, University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Craiova, Romania (DMD 1995). She specialized in stomatology as a resident in general stomatology (1995-1997). She was the laureate of two competitions as a result of which she became a stomatologist specializing in general stomatology (1997) and dental specialist (2003). In 2005 she was awarded her DDM by the “Grigore T. Popa” University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Iasi, Romania.

She joined the Faculty of Dental Medicine in Craiova as assistant lecturer (1999), and moved on in her career as Lecturer (2005), Assistant Professor (2008) and tenured Professor (2015).

She organized 12 congresses and 5 conferences (2009 - to present). She authored 6 books, co-authored 14 books, published, 49 articles, over 200 scientific papers in abstract, and was a member of 7 scientific research projects.
